- View and download information from other companies.
- Alert me to bugs you find.
- Alert me to functionality enhancements you would like to see in a later version.
- Answer the questions below by June 27, 2007 and forward your answers to roamingquestions@cdg.org.
 - Please share any positive or negative thoughts about the ease of use, functionality and value of this tool.
 - Did you notice any bugs, text errors or functionality problems?
 - What additional functionality would you like to see added to this tool?
